

Did you know...?

- *The average homeownership rate for Asian Americans is 53.2 percent; significantly lower than the national average 66.2 percent. For Native Hawaiians and Other Pacific Islanders, the national average is 45.5 percent. (Source: Census 2000)*
- *A nationwide study conducted by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in 2001 and 2002 found that AAPIs face significant levels of discriminations when searching for housing in large metropolitan areas.*
